Youth Choir

St. John's Choirs are well-known in the greater Hartford community and beyond as a center of excellence in vocal training and repertoire for children ages 7-1/2 and up. The youth choristers receive a stipend to sing the soprano (treble) line every other Sunday, alongside volunteers and professionals on the other parts. The choir has a flexible performing schedule with the highest standards of musical expression within a safe, supportive, inspiring environment.

Affiliated with the Royal School of Church Music, the program focuses on a centuriesold tradition of music composed originally for children's voices alongside adults. The youth also sing on their own periodically and for special occasions. Included are a summer choir camp, choir festivals and collaborations, and the broadening experience of travel. Rehearsals are on Wednesdays, and include a choir dinner twice per month.
